If you are interested in signing your child up for a discovery workshop, please review all of the following information, as well as the specifics for each workshop.

**Please note that there are changes in the registration process.**

Registration for workshops is now completely online. Registration must be completed by the deadline listed for the workshop. You may register for a workshop up until 11:59 p.m. on the deadline day. After the deadline, an additional late fee of \$20 will be implemented. If you need help with registration, please contact the teacher conducting the workshop or ask for assistance from Stacey Fleming or Dawn Osborn in the office. You are highly encouraged to make payment online. If necessary, you may send in a check in a labeled envelope; this must be done after registering online in order for your registration to be processed. You will receive a confirmation e-mail after your registration is complete. It is important to note that registration will be given on a first-come, first-served basis. Once a workshop is full, registration for that workshop will be closed.

In order to ensure quality activities, teachers have listed a minimum and maximum number of students. If the minimum requirement is not met, it will be up to the discretion of the teachers whether the workshop will take place. In the event that the workshop is cancelled, you will be notified and your payment will be returned to you. If the workshop exceeds the maximum, the teacher may decide to open additional sections of the workshop. In that instance, you would be notified of alternate dates.

Students are expected to be picked up promptly at the workshop dismissal time. Parents should park in the west parking lot and pick up students at the west entrance (K-2 carline). Unless otherwise noted, students will be picked up at this standard location. If your child is to be picked up in the building, please be sure to park in the parking lot and not in the circle drive.
